



Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) — Document Checklist

For visa-exempt travellers flying to or transiting through Canada. The eTA is linked electronically to your passport.

An eTA is for air travel and is usually valid up to 5 years or until your passport expires. If you need a visitor visa instead, use the Visitor Visa checklist.

How to use this: Tick each box as you gather the document. Bring the completed file to your CHK consultation so we can review it before you submit.

What you need

- Valid passport from an eTA-eligible (visa-exempt) country
- A valid email address
- A credit or debit card to pay the application fee
- Basic travel details
