



PR Card Renewal — Document Checklist

For permanent residents renewing or replacing a PR card from inside Canada.

If you are outside Canada without a valid PR card, you generally need a PR Travel Document instead — see that checklist.

How to use this: Tick each box as you gather the document. Bring the completed file to your CHK consultation so we can review it before you submit.

Eligibility

- You have met the residency obligation (at least 730 days in Canada within the last 5 years)

Core documents

- Current or expired PR card (or an explanation if lost/stolen)
- Two PR-card photos meeting specifications
- A copy of one valid government-issued photo ID
- Documents supporting your days in Canada (travel history, employment, lease, tax records)
- Completed application form (IMM 5444)
