



Refugee Travel Document — Document Checklist

For protected persons and certain permanent residents who cannot use a passport from their country of nationality.

Do not use a passport from your country of nationality to travel — doing so can affect your protected status. The Refugee Travel Document is issued by the Passport Program.

How to use this: Tick each box as you gather the document. Bring the completed file to your CHK consultation so we can review it before you submit.

Core documents

- Proof of protected-person status or PR obtained through protection
- Valid PR card or status documents
- Passport-style photos meeting specifications
- Completed application (PPTC 192) and applicable fee
