



Study Permit Extension — Document Checklist

For students extending a study permit from inside Canada. Apply before your current permit expires (ideally 30+ days ahead).

If your study permit has already expired, you generally cannot simply extend — see the Restoration of Status checklist and act within 90 days.

How to use this: Tick each box as you gather the document. Bring the completed file to your CHK consultation so we can review it before you submit.

Status & identity

- Valid passport covering your intended study period
- Copy of your current study permit; digital photo if required

Enrolment & progress

- Proof of enrolment or a new Letter of Acceptance / enrolment letter from your DLI
- Transcripts showing satisfactory academic progress
- Quebec only: updated CAQ

Finances

- Proof of funds for continued tuition and living costs
